HAPPY NEW YEAR to you all from NASSPDA's Board of Directors!

This year starts off right away with our North American Championships on January 13th and 14th, hosted by "Floorplay in the Desert" and held in Palm Springs, CA, the most prestigious title to garner within the community of NASSPDA (<http://www.floorplaypalmsprings.com/>). In its second year, this event promises to be well attended and much fun. Good luck to all participants!

Then in April our biggest event of the year, "April Follies" (<http://www.aprilfollies.com/>), will take place, now in its 15th year, held in Oakland, CA, on April 29th and hosting as always the California State Championships. A truly amazing event each year organized by the very skilled and knowledgeable volunteers of BASSDA (Bay Area Same-Sex Dance Association).

Shortly thereafter, in the week following Memorial Day our communities biggest event will take place in Miami, FL, IFSSDA's World Championships, being part of the 2017 World Outgames (<http://www.outgames.org/sports/dance-sport>), which are held every 4 years, in the year preceding the Gay Games. This 4-day long competition is preceded by 4 days of Country Western dancing and brings together dancers from all corners of the world and showcases the best of what our community has to offer.

Other events to follow in 2017 will be the "Glitz & Glitter Ball," held in Columbus, OH, the "Montreal Rainbow Dance Challenge," held in Montreal, QB, Canada, the "Delaware Valley Equality Ball," held in Woodbury, NJ, and the "Provincetown Dance Trophy," held on Cape Cod, MA.

The annual elections to NASSPDA's Board of Directors will take place in May. Please remember that in order to renew your membership, we are asking all previous members of NASSPDA to newly join, just as any new member would have to, rather than renew one's membership. Yes, that means entering your data all over again and creating new log-in credentials, since it was too daunting a process transferring the encrypted data to the new platform. However, this new platform allows for all annual memberships to be independent from the calendar year and will now be tied to the year based on the date of joining. 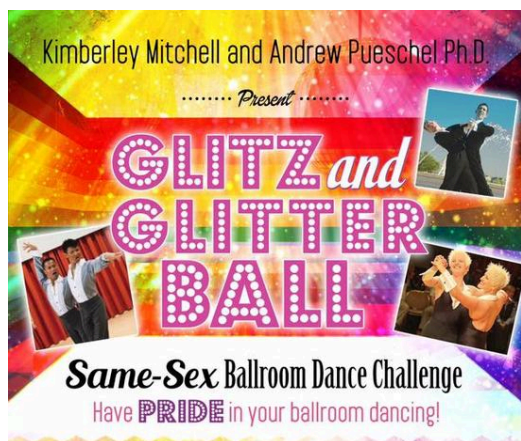
