From the President

We hope that the New Year got off to a good start for all of you!

As with each year, it is time to renew your commitments, including your membership with NASSPDA. We all know that as an organization our voice is only as strong as our membership. NASSPDA is a member of the FGG (Federation of Gay Games), a member of GLISA (Gay & Lesbian International Sports Association) and a founding member of IFSSDA (International Foundation of Same-Sex Dance Associations). Here are brief updates on our involvements with these organizations:

The FGG is currently in the midst of a heated debate about two issues, trying to create a combined event by the FGG & GLISA based on popular demand and prohibiting events at the Gay Games to be sanctioned as "World Championships." The resolution of both issues would impact our community as much as any other sport, but in particular the latter. Due to limited resources and failure to yet finalize the formation of IFSSDA by registering it as a legal entity and creating governing by-laws and rules, the founding organizations, ESSDA, IAGLCWDC & NASSPDA, have decided that each Gay Games and World Outgames event will be considered the "World Championships" for Dancesport. Apparently, other sports have made the same determination, though some ask the organizers of the Gay Games for licensing fees before granting such title, which adds a financial burden to organizing the games, and/or have qualification requirements in place, which contradict the "inclusion-of-all and "personal-best" mantra of the games.

GLISA is a more complicated organization, having continental bodies that also hold their own events, such as the upcoming North America Outgames in St. Louis. Since the formation of GLISA, caused by disagreements over the organization of Gay Games 7, originally to be held in Montreal and then hosted by Chicago, and due to its more complicated structure, many FGG members have a very negative stand towards GLISA, which hampers negotiations for a combined event. Any organization can be a member of both, the FGG as well as GLISA, and many are, just like NASSPDA.

Therefore, it could be argued that joining forces again as one organization would make sense, though many in the FGG fear that that would mean losing the initially intended focus and spirit of the Gay Games, since GLISA seems to focus less on sport and more on human rights issue focused events.

IFSSDA was formed in 2010 at Gay Games 8 in Cologne, Germany, based on an initiative by ESSDA & NASSPDA. A preceding survey revealed that the community is interested in worldwide representation and an event that would officially carry the title of "World Championship." Together, both organizations created a six person committee, which rewrote the "Red Book," the rules that govern each sport and its sanction as well as organization at the Gay Games. IAGLCWDC joined shortly thereafter, and a constitution was drafted, which got signed in 2013 by all three organizations at the World Outgames in Antwerp. The Dancesport event at these Outgames was for the first time sanctioned to be IFSSDA's World Championships, and it was agreed that all following Gay Games and World Outgames shall be officially "our" World Championships, which is how our community had viewed these events anyway.

NASSPDA continues to be involved, but can only do so effectively, if it has a score of members to support its efforts. To that end, please remember to renew your membership with NASSPDA or, if you haven't yet, join us, so that we have a stronger voice on these and other issues.
