

NASSPDA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please note that any and all information you share with us is CONFIDENTIAL. It will be accessible ONLY to the NASSPDA Scholarship Committee. Your contact information will never be shared with anyone regarding this application, and your name will never be shared unless you specifically give us permission on your application to do so.

The NASSPDA Scholarship Fund had been established at the end of 2012 to provide funding for dancers who wish to compete in the 2013 North American Championship, expanded in 2014 to include IFSSDA's World Championship, when it was held in North America, and as of 2018 is open to all dancers (members and non-members), who wish to compete in any NASSPDA sanctioned event (see http://nasspda.org/calendar/) and lack the necessary funds, especially with a focus on those who are new to the competitive scene.

Prior to each calendar year, NASSPDA's Board will decide based on available funds how many scholarships will be available and in what amounts. This information will be published each year on NASSPDA's website, in its monthly eNewsletter and on its Facebook Page. Each awarded scholarship includes a free membership to NASSPDA either for the year in which the applicant has applied or for the following year.

Qualifications for the Scholarship

- 1. Newcomers to competing are particularly encouraged to apply.
- 2. Former applicant may apply again, even if awarded in the past, but priority will be given to those applicants who apply for the first time.
- 3. Applicant shall be at least the minimum age required by the particular NASSPDA sanctioned event.
- 4. Applicant shall make a case for need of financial assistance, in order to attend competition.

Application Rules

Application shall be submitted to NASSPDA (e-mailed or postmarked) no later than ninety (90) days prior to the NASSPDA sanctioned event to be attended. Late applications may be accepted under certain circumstances. Instructions for submitting this application are at the bottom of this form. Once approved, scholarship funds will be distributed after the applicant has completed participation in the chosen event.

It is important that all contact information on this application be accurate and up to date so that the NASSPDA Scholarship Approval Committee may contact the applicant at any time during the selection process. Any changes should be reported immediately to the Chair of NASSPDA's Scholarship Committee, NASSPDA's President.
