#### A VERY HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL!!!

NASSPDA's Board of Directors hopes that you all had a good start into this New Year! May this year bring us all joy and peace!

This year will after a long hiatus thankfully feature some NASSPDA sanctioned events once again. To start with, Boston Open Dancesport will host the '2023 Boston Open DanceSport Championships' on April 1, 2023, which will also feature this year's USA Championships

(<u>http://www.bostonopendancesport.com/competition.html</u>). Following that, the Bay Area Same-Sex Dance Association (BASSDA) will bring back 'April Follies' with an afternoon of performances and social dancing on April 29, 2023,

(https://www.aprilfollies.com/grand-event) and 'Floorplay LA'

(<u>https://www.floorplayevents.com/</u>) will have an event in June of 2023, with exact date and location to be announced.

The 11<sup>th</sup> Gay Games will be hosted this year in November by two cities, Hong Kong (China) and Guadalajara (Mexico). Dancesport will solely be offered in Guadalajara from November 5 through 8, 2023, (<u>https://gggdl2023.org/en</u>) with more details, such as venue and a schedule for each day still to be worked out. This will be the first event that will be governed by IFSSDA's Competition Rules, aside from the Red Book for Dancesport from the FGG.

The following lists some of what NASSPDA's Board of Directors is working on in 2023:

NASSPDA's numbers of active members that pay annual dues have dwindled over the past two years, clearly as a result from the pandemic and the subsequent lack of training and events. Membership had always been driven by a discount offered to members at registration for competitions as well as the ability to garner NASSPDA championship titles. Naturally, this situation has also resulted into zero applications for NASSPDA's scholarships and activity grants in 2022. Taking all this into account, the Board decided to temporarily place on hold both the Scholarship and the Activity Grant Programs and institute instead for 2023 an Event Sponsorship for recurring sanctioned NASSPDA events, namely 'April Follies,' 'Floorplay LA' and 'Boston Open DanceSport Championships.' These events are well established and have a proven track record as well as have been established to serve NASSPDA's community without the intent to make a profit, but are struggling to stay afloat. In turn, these events will be required to offer NASSPDA members a registration or entrance discount of no less than \$10 and promote NASSPDA leading up to and throughout the event. It is the Board's hope that this measure will help revitalize the alternative dance scene for our community, in line with NASSPDA's mission (https://nasspda.org/mission-statement/), after which it makes more sense again in 2024 or even prior reinstituting the two aforementioned programs. NASSPDA will also take this as an opportunity to look into restructuring both programs, in order to attract more applications and to directly benefit members and increase membership.

As every year, the two-year terms of some Board members will expire by mid-May and most have agreed to stand again for reelection. Due to an increased workload for achieving his goal, a PhD in Theatre and Performance Studies at York University (Canada), Rufi Oswaldo has announced his resignation from the Board. This was his first term serving on the Board. NASSPDA and its constituency is grateful for that contribution, and his valuable input during that time will be missed. Other Board members standing for reelection are Emma DiFrancesco, Susie Hoskins, Erik Jaeger, Jo Popadynetz and Benjamin Soencksen. If you know of anyone, especially from Canada, that you could recommend for serving on NASSPDA's Board of Directors, including yourself, and who might have a specific set of skills that could be valuable to the work NASSPDA does (any questions about that, please contact me directly at <u>bsoencksen@nasspda.org</u>), please visit the page on NASSPDA's website that informs you about the process and links to two required Google forms to be submitted (<u>https://nasspda.org/board-member-election/</u>).

NASSPDA's Board continues to also actively look for candidates for the Ambassadorship Program developed by the Promotion Committee. This program seeks individuals and/or couples that will spread the word about and impart the values of NASSPDA at events other than sanctioned by NASSPDA. This ambassadorship comes with a stipend to cover some expenses and the provision of promotional material.
