Recap of NASSPDA's 2023 USA & Massachusetts State Championships - Hosted by Boston Open DanceSport

After a year without any NASSPDA sanctioned events due to the effects of the Pandemic, the organizing team of Boston Open Dancesport led by Kalin Mitov held its annual event on April 1, 2023, once again in Dedham, MA. The previous event, held in October of 2021, was the fourth named 'New England Open' and hosted NASSPDA's North American Championships.

This year the team decided to revert to the previous name of 'Boston Open Dancesprt Championships,' hosting this time NASSPDA's USA and Massachusetts State Championships. The venue in Dedham, MA, was as in 2021 the large hall of the St. John of Damascus Church, beautifully lit and decorated by the organizing team. Especially welcome, since the day started very cloudy and damp, which though later changed to bright sunshine, noticeable through a skylight, brightening up the space even more. Lots of free snacks and pizza during the break delighted in particular the participating youth at this event.

In comparison to 2021, the number of participants almost doubled, resulting in a quarter more entries. The judging panel, Eddie Alba, Sarah Billings, Lee Fox, Richard Jones and Patti Panebianco, led by head judge Benjamin Soencksen, all NASSPDA approved, adjudicated a wide variety of events, including the USA & Massachusetts State Championships. The title winners, Justin Miller & James Repetti, in Men's A-Class of American Style Smooth & Rhythm, International Style Standard & Latin as well as Showdance (Couples) and Holly Stone & Michael Winward in Open-Role Showdance (Couples) are high level and proud representations of NASSPDA's dance community.
