For 2023, NASSPDA's Board had decided to place on hold the Scholarship and the Activity Grant Programs and institute instead an Event Sponsorship for recurring sanctioned events, namely 'April Follies,' 'Floorplay LA' and 'Boston Open DanceSport Championships'.

These events have been well established and have had a proven track record as well as have been established to serve NASSPDA's community without the intent to make a profit, as reported in the January 2023 eNewsletter.

All three events have now taken place and the organizers shared the following with the Board:

April Follies

After many, many years of fabulous April Follies competitions, followed by the COVID-19 pandemic, which shut it down completely for 4 years, the three remaining members of the AF committee made the decision to have one final celebration on April 29, 2023. This was NOT to be a competition, but a swan song of dancing and tributes to all the legendary dancers, spectators, committee members and judges from all the previous years. And, as part of its newly established 2023 Event Sponsorship Program, NASSPDA donated \$1000 to support this huge effort, enabling April Follies to truly go out with a bang, with amazing dance demonstrations, lots of social dancing, a free dinner, and topping off the day-long event with a grand show, entitled 'Platforms 20-30', produced by Photis Pishiaris, and starring many of the past AF competitors.

Boston Open DanceSport Championships

Due to the devastating effects of the Pandemic and the ever-changing landscape of the world in general, this grant from NASSPDA made a huge difference. It allowed us to keep our doors open, being a stage for the remaining fewer same-sex dancers and keeping the love for competing and performing alive. We knew that this is our call and our duty to the dance community.

NASSPDA Inclusivity Statement

In light of recent aggressions targeting specifically transgender, non-binary, and gender non-conforming folks in several states in the USA and Canada, NASSPDA wishes to make its position explicitly clear. We welcome all gender identities and expressions, including specifically folks who have transitioned or are transitioning and gender non-conforming individuals. NASSPDA has zero tolerance for harassment or discrimination of any of its members.

To create a safer space for trans- and gender non-conforming folk, we invite NASSPDA-sanctioned event organizers to implement the following actions:

Use each dancer's self-disclosed pronouns.

Provide gender-inclusive washrooms, or make reasonable efforts to reserve certain washrooms for all genders in venues that do not have them.

Similarly, provide gender-inclusive change rooms, if applicable.

Offer dancers means of reporting harassment or discrimination safely and anonymously.

Consider developing security protocols that address the physical safety of the event. This could include identification verification during registration, incident response plans at events, evacuation plans, maintaining lists of emergency contacts, etc.



Ambassador Program

In need of broader visibility, better promotion in the DanceSport world and advocating for same-sex competitive dancing, NASSPDA is looking to engage Ambassadors.

As many North American DanceSport organizations have changed their definition of a dance couple, we are witnessing interest and participation of newly formed same-sex, reverse role, and gender-neutral couples at their

events. Many of those couples haven't been introduced or exposed to NASSPDA as an organization; hence, they also do not know the benefits of being a member of NASSPDA.
